
excitement outdoor parks & playgrounds

- 1. Skeena View Park: Tennis courts, new pickleball courts, a kids playground.
- 2. Christy Park: Soccer pitches and green space.
- 3. Riverside Park: Ball diamonds and green space.
- 4. Elks Park: Ball diamonds, kids playground and picnic area.
- 5. Rotary & Kerr Park: Baseball diamond and a kids playground.
- 6. Off leash dog parks: Ferry Island #11, next to Parkside School next #2 and next to Elks Park #4 on Haugland.


